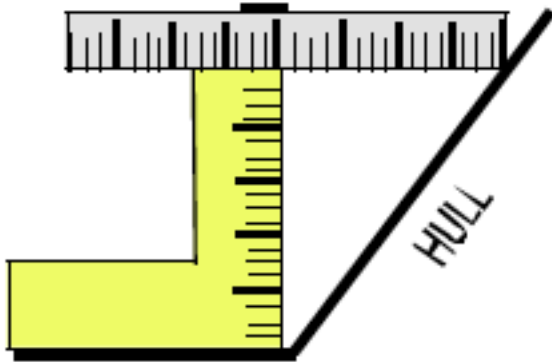

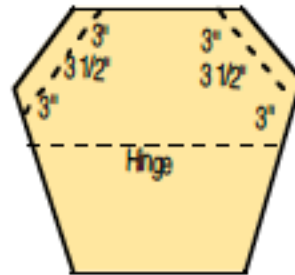
1) Start pattern by covering the entire deck/berth with paper/plastic. Allow at least 6 inches of extra paper along all sides. Use your finger to crease the paper/plastic along the hull and end keepers.

2) Then use a pencil and trace along the crease.



3) With paper/pastic still on the deck. Measure beveled edges at 6"- 8" intervals using a square an a ruler. Place the ruler 6" up on the square and measure the distance to the hull. Mark the spot and distance on the paper/plastic where the measurement was taken. Repeat this every 6-8 inches.

4) Complete the pattern by adding any lines in the area that you want your mattress to fold (hinge). Put your name, phone number, boat make, model and year on pattern.
